RECOMMENDED RESOLUTION: *Resolved*, That the West Virginia Higher Education Policy Commission approves tuition and fees for the 2010-11 academic year.

BACKGROUND:

At the April 23, 2010 meeting, Chancellor Noland led discussion regarding tuition and fees for the 2010-11 academic year. As part of the discussion, the Commission received information regarding the current economic climate and the potential impact on institutional operating budgets. Chancellor Noland reported that 49 states are currently experiencing budget deficits with more than half of those states reducing operational budgets for higher education. Regional and national tuition and fee comparisons, including peer institutions, were also presented and are included for the Commission's review.

West Virginia Code §18B-10-1(k)(5) requires the Commission to approve any proposed tuition and fee increases for state institutions of higher education other than Marshall University and West Virginia University. As a result, Commission staff has compiled and analyzed institutional requests as approved by the respective governing boards for the Commission's consideration.

Institutions requiring approval by the Commission are not seeking a base increase in tuition and fees for the 2010-11 academic year for resident undergraduate students consistent with Governor Manchin's directive to freeze tuition and fees. For non-resident undergraduate students, proposed fee increases range from 0.51 percent to 6.69 percent. Additionally, proposed fee increases for graduate students range from 0.89 percent to 15.48 percent for resident students and 1.91 percent to 24.90 percent for non-resident students.

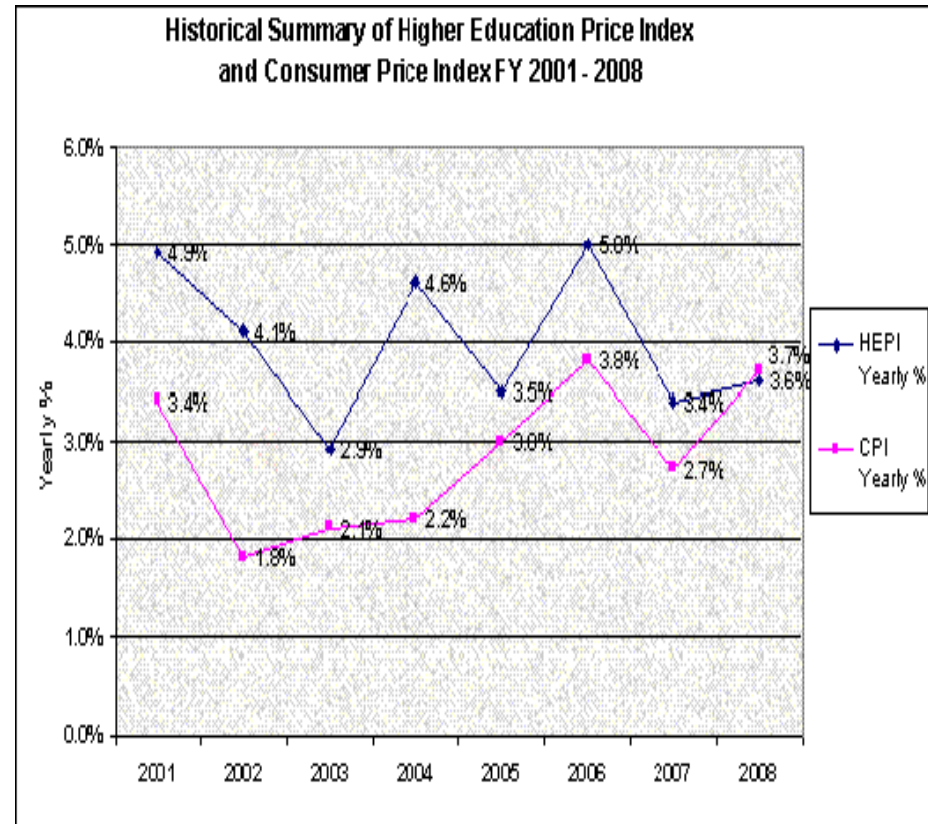

Financial Challenges in American Higher Education

- The current economic downturn presents a series of challenges for the nation's post-secondary system. The traditional reliance upon student generated revenues to minimize reductions in state funding is challenged by tensions of access and affordability.
- Many institutions have adopted layoffs and furloughs, eliminated academic programs and student support services, closed colleges, limited course offerings, increased class sizes, and capped enrollment to offset budget reductions and minimize tuition and fee increases.
- States such as Tennessee have increased per credit hour charges by moving the base level for full-time tuition to 15 hours and are “charging” on a per-credit hour basis for hours above and beyond the floor.
- Protests emerged across California in response to a 32% mid-year tuition increase. The fee increase was instituted to offset a \$584 million budget deficit. The CSU system also adjusted policies to allow employee furloughs of two days per month; approximately 85 percent of CSU's budget costs are employee salaries/benefits.

Operating Budgets – National Context

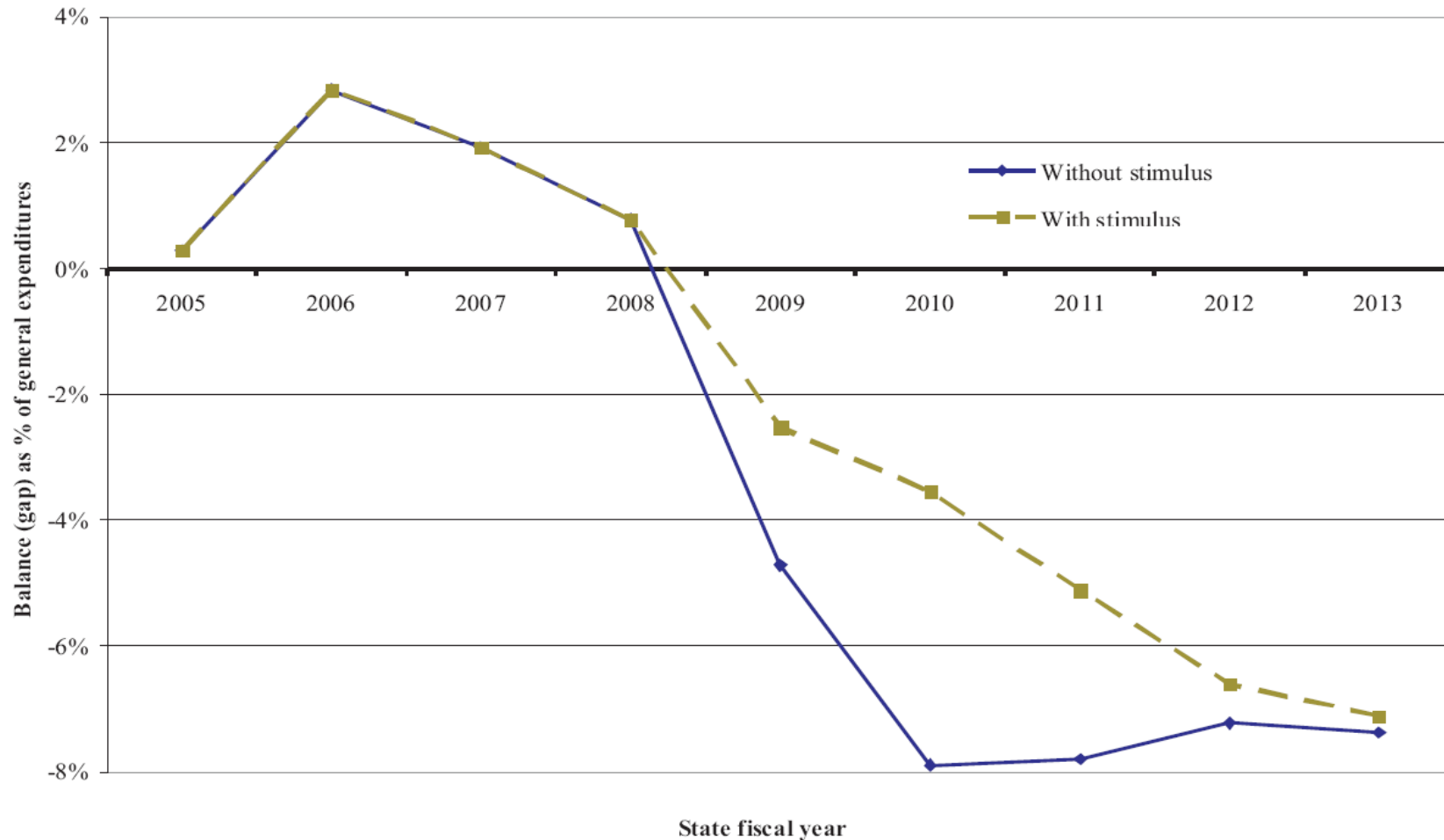
- Currently, 49 states nationally are experiencing budget deficits, with more than half reducing operating budgets for higher education.
- By fall 2009, 15 of the 16 SREB states had experienced budget reduction ranging from 1 percent in Arkansas to 21 percent in South Carolina.
- Preliminary estimates indicate that each of the 16 member states in the SREB will experience budget reductions during FY 2010.
- However, stimulus funds may be utilized in many of these states to offset reductions in operating revenues.



After stimulus, budget gaps could approach 7 percent of spending or \$120 billion under the “High-Gap” scenario.

"High-Gap" Scenario:

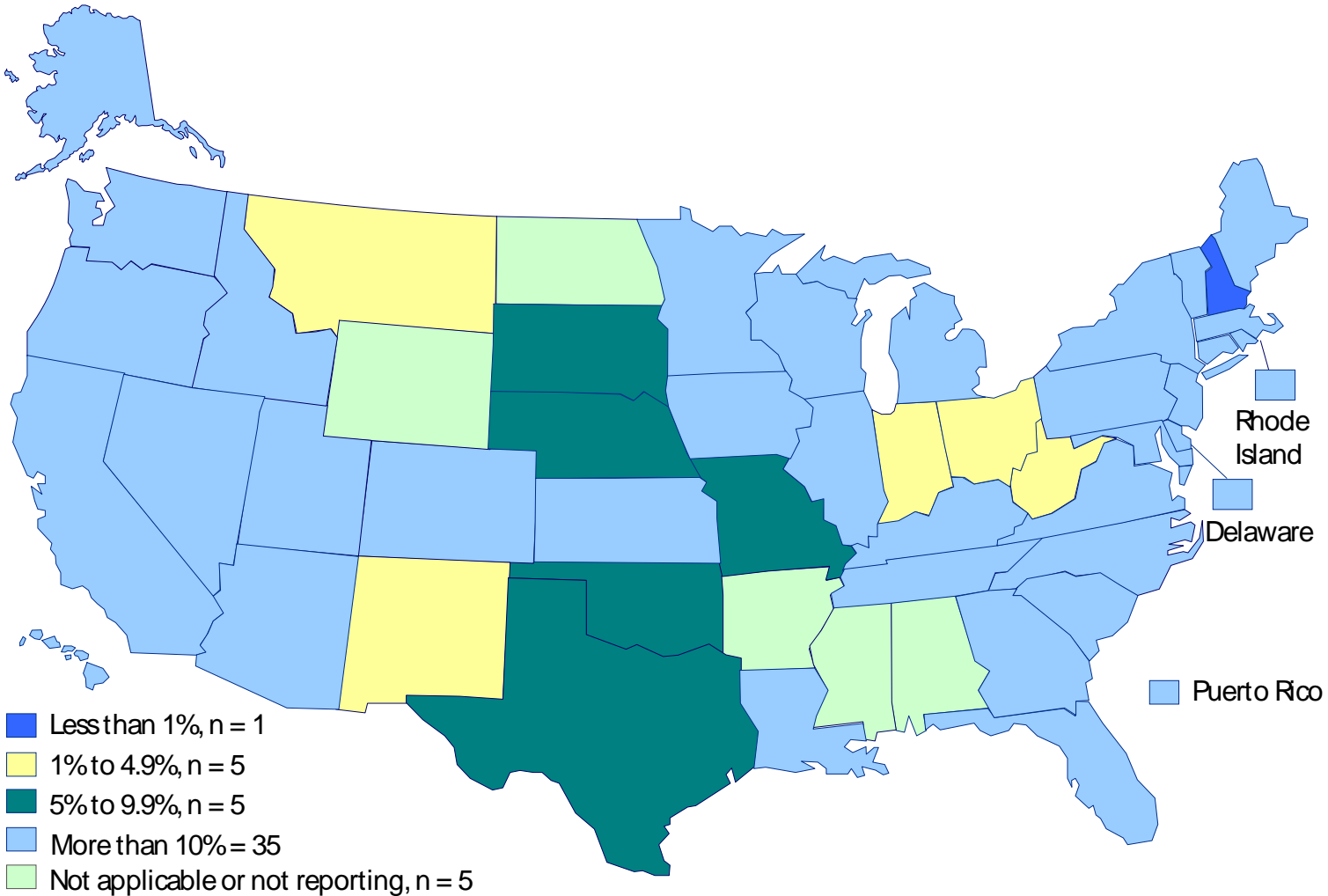
State General Revenue Minus Expenditures With and Without Federal Stimulus

Institutional Operating Budgets

- \$24,645,944 in total revenues would be required under normal circumstances for institutional operating budgets to cover inflation and fixed costs increases. This figure is equivalent to the change in the Higher Education Price Index (HEPI) from FY 2008 to FY 2009 (3.6 percent).
- In addition to inflationary factors, institutions require funding to support enrollment growth and to maintain competitiveness with peer institutions. The figure referenced above assumes that all factors, including enrollment, remain fixed.
- Regardless of inflationary, peer, or formula calculations, higher education in West Virginia trails regional and peer averages with respect to total revenues available to support institutional operations.

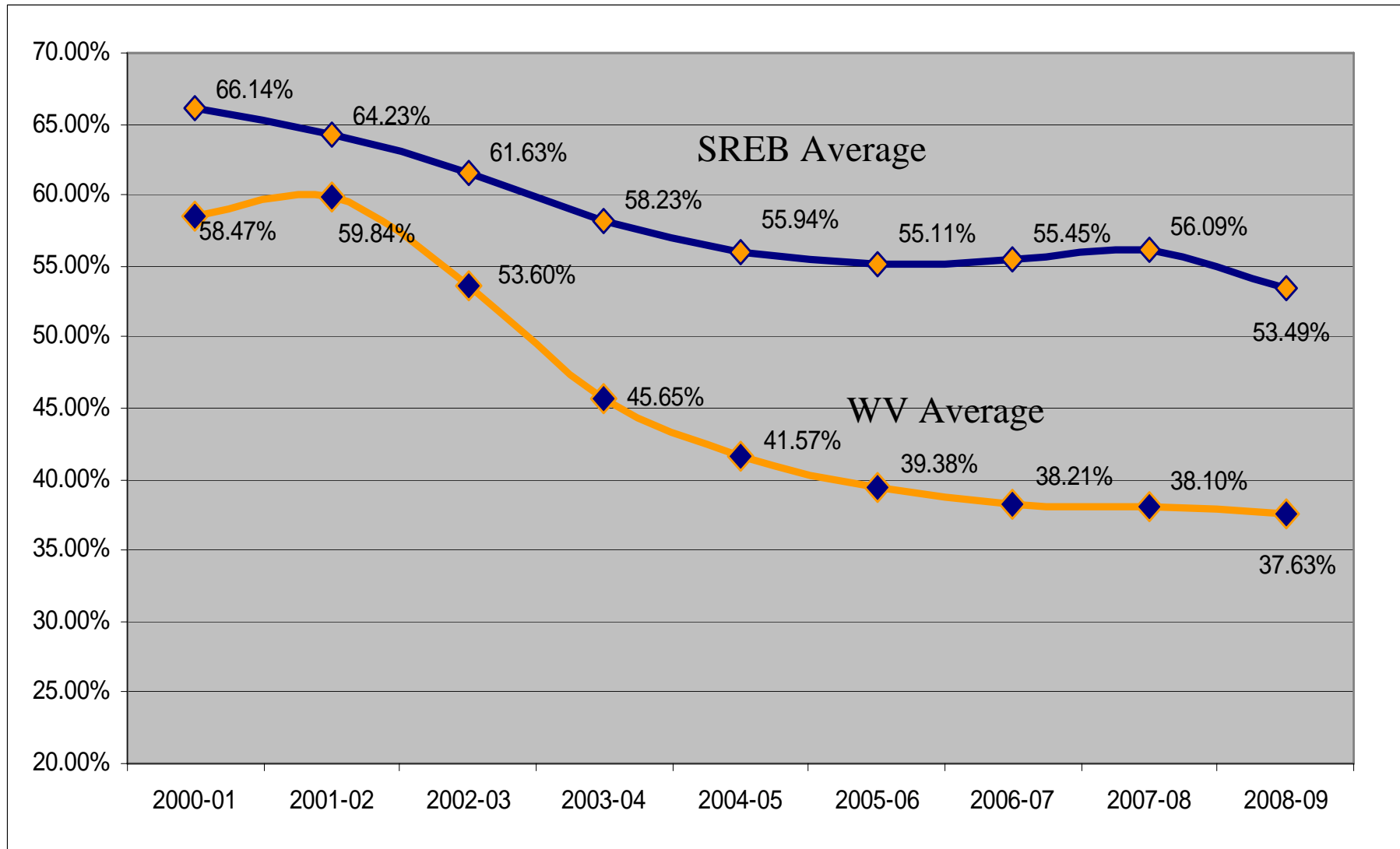

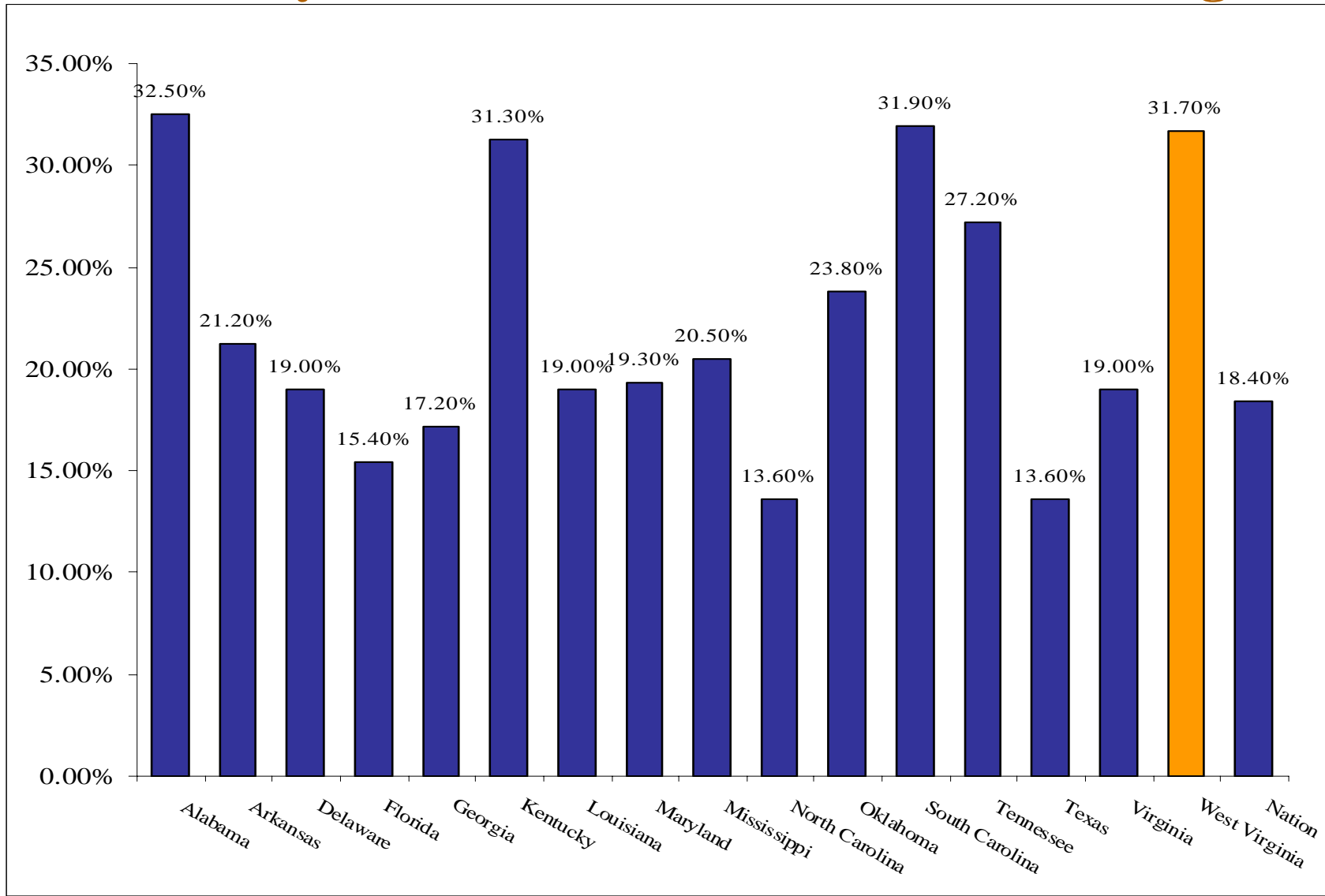

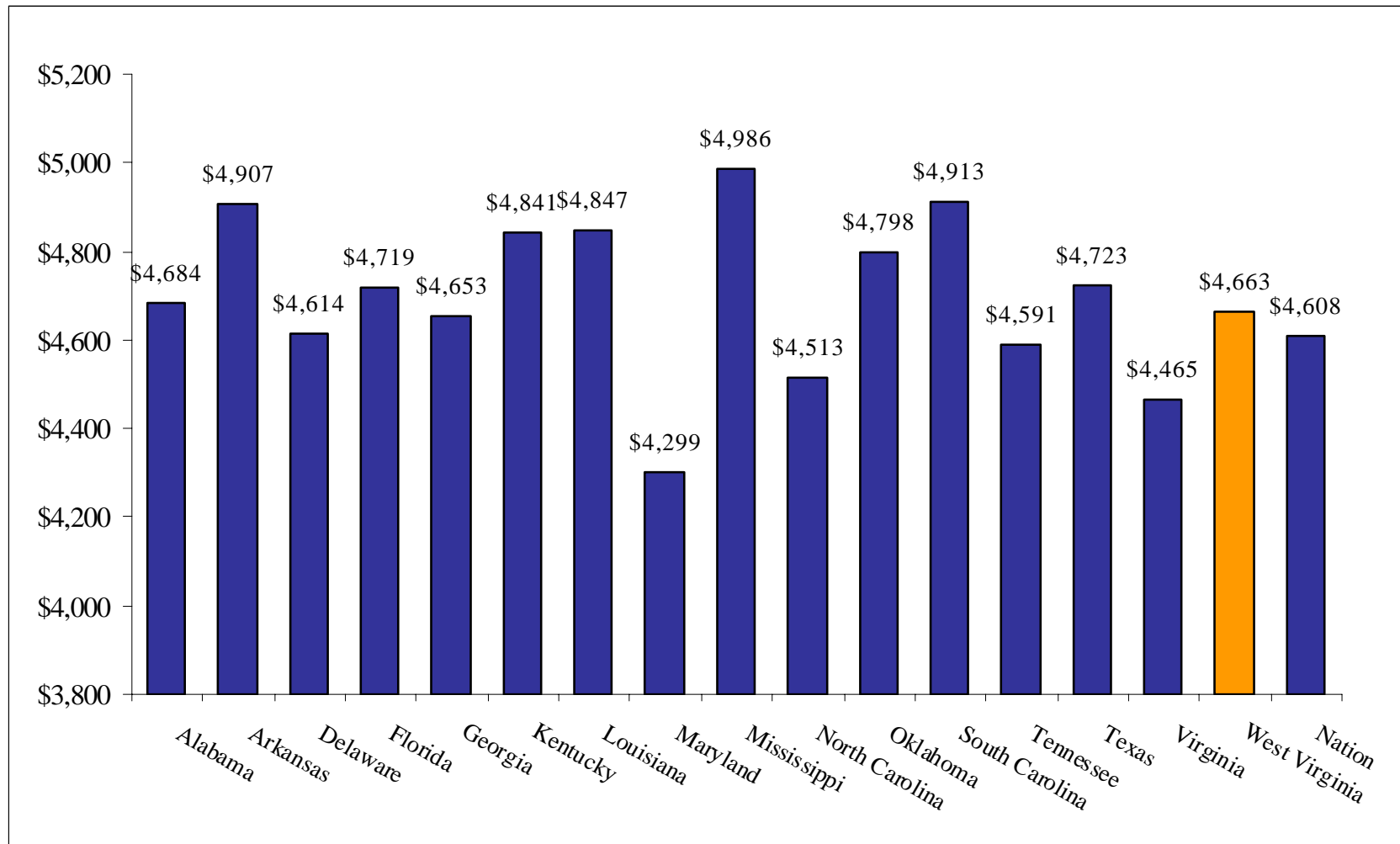
